Elevator Test Check List

Test the Elevator smokes and recall.

Developed by

Verify smoke detectors are installed on all floors at elevator lobby.

Verity smoke partitions if Installed at all elevator lobbies in buildings serving more than two floors. (Exception is main floor lobby with no basement or lower level elevator access.)

Activate smoke detector on subsequent floor.

Watch elevators arrive at primary floor and stay open.

Insert override key and turn to FD override and then to fire service "on",

Remove key (still in FD override) and insert key into FS in elevator car.

Turn car FS "on".

Close elevator doors.

Push desired floor.

Car should travel to floor and car doors stay closed.

Open car doors using > door function.

Releasing door <> button before doors are fully open should cause automatic door closure.

Return car to ground ievel.

Open doors.

Turn FS key off in car.

Insert and turn FS key switch In lobby to override and then to off.

Cars should be restored after control panel is reset.
