



Seasonal Firefighter Recruitment

The District is anticipating the need for seasonal firefighters this year. Seasonal firefighters may be assigned to a shift working the 2 x 4 (48 hrs. on 96 hrs. off) schedule with a 48-hour duty period. The anticipated employment period is from May through October 2018. The first 4 – 6 weeks seasonal firefighters may be assigned to 40-hour workweek assisting with fire prevention. This period is determined by the needs of the District.

Minimum qualifications at time of appointment include:

- 18 years of age
- High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Current Professional Provider CPR card
- Valid, non-restricted California driver's license
- Valid CA. EMT-B License
- FF 1 Academy Certification

Desirable Qualifications:

- Successful completion of Marin County Wildland Academy or California (Cal Fire) Wildland Certificate or other training as approved by the District
- Current firefighting and EMS experience
- College Fire Science studies
- NWCG Firefighter Type 2

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Ability to learn firefighting tactics and EMS techniques
- Ability to learn the operation and maintenance of equipment
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions
- Ability to communicate effectively
- Ability to do strenuous physical activity for extended periods of time

The District may require candidates to attend and successfully complete a wildland firefighter training seminar or additional training as directed by the District training officer in lieu of the Marin County Wildland Academy.

Compensation, \$2,426 - \$3,640 PER MONTH. This is a non-benefit position.
